

- 'Do you, or will you, have any qualifications from this centre?' Select 'Yes'
- **SAVE**
- **CLICK 'ADD QUALIFICATION'.** It is advisable to have your transcript(s) next to you so you can copy the information for each module as required.



GO TO THE 'SEARCH BY NAME' BAR. If you are studying the NCC Education Level 3 International Foundation Diploma for Higher Education Studies (L3IFDHES), select 'International qualifications' and search for 'NCC'.
